



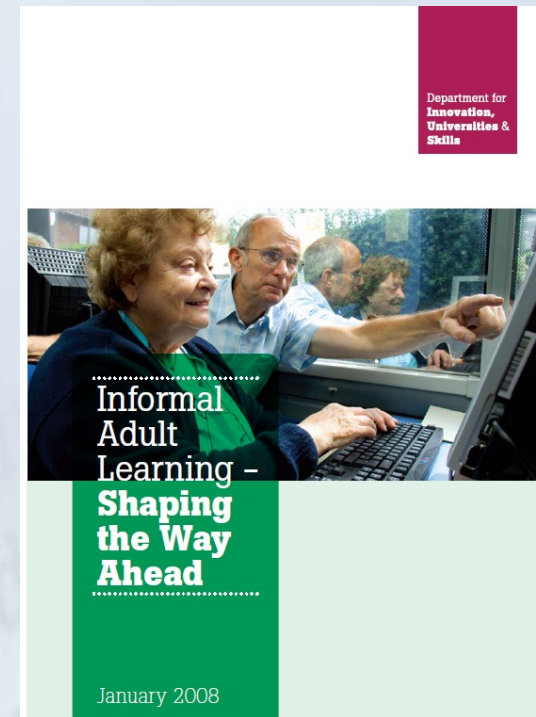

The Learning Revolution

Progress so far in Surrey...

April 2008...

- 3 Action for Communities Partnerships debate the DIUS Informal Adult Learning consultative document
- A countywide response is submitted to DIUS



March – June 2009

- Learning Revolution White Paper published
- SLLP Annual Conference takes the theme: 'Revolution or Evolution?'



July-August 2009

- Delegates invited to join together in bidding to the Learning Revolution Transformation Fund
- One Partnership bid submitted to cover the county and incorporate 15 partner organisations.

September-October 2009

- Partnership bid led by Surrey LLP is awarded £98,750
- Inclusive project with all bid partners forming the steering group
- Employed a 'Champion for Transformation' to work with learning providers and community workers to put foundations in place.



TransformIT

- *Project aim is to transform the way information technology is used in the delivery of informal adult learning in the community,*
- *The Project will develop the capacity of tutors and trained intermediaries capable of using the latest technology and media in creative ways to bring new approaches to learning in the community*

- Mentoring for tutors:
 - 'Starter for 10' materials produced and sent out to network of trainers for testing & feedback
 - Trainer handbook being produced
 - Mentoring sessions planned
 - Using web & new technology in adult learning
- Social networking training provided or planned for:
 - Community Development Workers
 - Surrey Community Action
 - Action for Carers
