## **CURRENT LEARNER NEED POSITION**

(a) The principal learning and community needs that have been identified in the borough are as follows

- **Rural Nature of the Borough**

The towns and villages that make up Waverley are in predominately rural locations with patchy public transport linking them. Rural isolation can affect people.

- **Gypsies and Travellers**

There are twelve Traveller sites with 96 authorised pitches, and three showmen sites with 7 authorised pitches.

- **Lack of qualifications**

According to the 2001 Census 32.2% of residents in Binscombe, and nearly 25% in Godalming Central and Ockford had no qualifications.

- **ESOL**

It is estimated that Farnham Castle Ward has a high need for ESOL (The Skills for Life Survey). Over the five year period 2002-07, there was been a 73% rise in National Insurance registrations from overseas nationals in Waverley.

## Godalming Central and Ockford

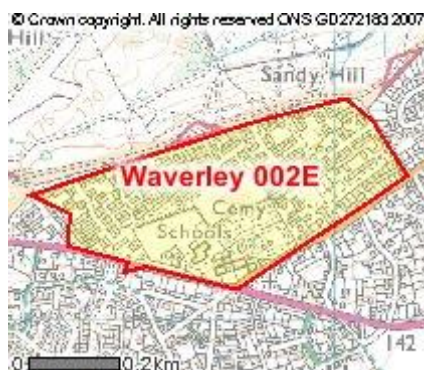


Area: Between Aaron's Hill and Eashing Lane.

**Godalming Central and Ockford** is the 6th most deprived ward in Surrey according to the indices of multiple deprivation (IMD). It features in the 20 most affected wards in Surrey for:

- Income deprivation (16th)
- Employment deprivation (5<sup>th</sup>)
- Health and Disability (6<sup>th</sup>)

## Farnham Upper Hale



Area: Upper Hale Road to Sandy Hill Road

**Farnham Upper Hale** is the 7<sup>th</sup> most deprived ward in Surrey according to the IMD. It features in the 20 lowest wards in Surrey for:

- Income deprivation (10th)
- Employment deprivation (17<sup>th</sup>)
- Health and Disability (18<sup>th</sup>)
- Education deprivation (3rd)

**Farncombe and Binscombe** which includes Godalming Binscombe (WAVERLEY 005C and 005B)



**Godalming Binscombe** ranks

- 11<sup>th</sup> in Employment Deprivation and
- 7<sup>th</sup> in Education Deprivation

**Farnham The Chantrys**



Area: sits top left corner of 003A and leads off West Street between University for the Creative Arts and A31 dual carriageway. This is a small and isolated area that is recognized by all agencies as having many needs, which is reinforced by statistics.

**Wrecclesham**



Area: Wrecclesham is the top half of the ward. Keyline Computing is working in both these areas and Surrey County Council Adult & Community Learning also view them as areas of focus.

### **NEEDS FOR NEW PROVISION IN WAVERLEY**

We need an infrastructure in Surrey that facilitates people to learn to read and write in their neighbourhood, otherwise we are never going to eradicate the low reading ability of many thousands of residents.

#### **Farnham:**

There is a need to develop input into Hale, Chantrys and Wrecclesham with classes that enable children and parents to learn together. The latter two are new areas, and need to be approached delicately; swamping them with learning is inadvisable. It is probably better engaging current learners and encouraging them to promote the present provision.

Once The Bungalow (Upper Hale) has re-opened and settled, this will be a good venue for new classes.

Another very small but difficult area is Roman Way, Farnham; this has been a hard area to break through, and the first learning episode is happening there this month<sup>1</sup> through community intermediaries and word of mouth. A longer class would be good, and then to engage with Family Learning if numbers can be sustained.

#### **Farncombe and Binscombe:**

Surrey County Council Adult & Community Learning Widening Participation are waiting to deliver OCN Horticulture (10 weeks x 2 hour accredited course), OCN Community Workskills (or Committee Skills) for the Northbourne Action Group and possibly a Healthy Cooking Taster (3 weeks x 2 hours) at the Loseley Fields Children Centre after Easter 2010.

These needs have been highlighted at the Lifelong Learning group, but timing is important to engage the community.

#### **Ockford Ridge:**

More learning that involves children and parents or other carers needs to be developed. On the back of the new windows and doors investment in the housing stock, it would be the perfect time to offer decorating skills workshops. A new resident's group is being supported by the WBC tenant participation project, and although in its infancy would benefit from capacity building.

The young people really benefitted and enjoyed bike workshop skills at the Skatepark last summer – a project that included both the young people and their parents might be a good community enterprise.

#### **Rural and Travellers:**

An expansion of family and adult learning in rural areas and on gypsy sites is desirable and is possible using the Surestart Mobile Playbus. This depends on capacity.
