Join our popular intensive or part-time PTLLS Course (Preparing to Teach in the Lifelong Learning Sector) which is an initial award, aimed at candidates who are:

- Pre-service and wish to explore the possibility of teaching in Post-16 education, or
- In-service and require an introduction to teaching in Post-16 education, or
- In-service and would like to progress to the full teaching qualification leading to QTLS status, or
- In-service and would like to progress to the teaching qualification leading to ATLS status for those with a more limited teaching role.

Fee: £190 course fee (including registration and certification) plus £25 college affiliation fee.

PTLLS plus

The Academy also offers the PTLLS Plus programmes below – for an additional £100 add 'Skills for Life' or 'Functional Skills' modules to your PTLLS Award:

PTLLS + Skills for Life:

This PTLLS programme has an additional module and is designed for people who are teaching or would like to teach within the Lifelong Learning Sector and would like to be more confident supporting learners' literacy or numeracy skills, or who may want to progress into teaching literacy or numeracy to adults.

PTLLS + Functional Skills:

The generic PTLLS course includes a session on how to embed Functional English, Maths and ICT into specialist areas. We have designed this 6-day PTLLS + course for people who would like an in depth introduction to teaching Functional Skills and who wish to increase their confidence supporting learners' Functional Skills and preparing learners for assessment. It is suitable for those who are already teaching but may be very new, or have had little or no teacher training.
